

WHAT IS A LASH EXTENSION REMOVAL AND DO I NEED IT?

So, you got the Lash Extensions of your dreams, now your vacation is over, and you just don't know if you can keep up the maintenance...Let's talk about your options!

At the end of a lash cycle, you will probably be able to see your natural lashes growing at the base of your lid and the thicker, darker extension would stand out more. Seeing it dangling on the middle of your lash line can be distracting. You may want to pull them off. **DO NOT DO THIS!** It will more likely than not damage your lash by ripping it out or weakening the hair. If you're thinking about removing your lash extensions, **do not do it yourself!!**

Go see a professional like me.. Removing your eyelash extensions at home just isn't worth the risk of damages your natural lashes. Think of it like a gel manicure – you can pick it off yourself, but you're better off going to a professional. It's worth the \$25 price tag.

The process takes less than half an hour. I use tiny tweezers and other tools specifically designed to remove lash extension.

Keep in mind, you have the option to wait it out and let our lashes fall of on their own. This can take up to five weeks depending on your lash growth cycle. I personally do not recommend waiting it out. Your false lashes will start to fall off, which creates opportunities to pick them off. As I mentioned above, avoid picking off your lashes yourself **AT ALL COSTS.**
